Author, activist, psychotherapist and film producer, Dwayne L. Buckingham releases his new film, **“A Black Man’s Worth! Conqueror and Head of Household”**

After the ground breaking success of his three released books: [A Black Woman’s Worth! My Queen and Backbone](#) in 2007; [A Black Man’s Worth! Conqueror and Head of Household](#) in 2008 and [Unconditional Love: What Every Woman and Man Desires in a Relationship](#) in 2009, Buckingham has taken his activism to the big screen in 2010 with the production and release of his new film, entitled, **“A Black Man’s Worth! Conqueror and Head of Household”**.

In his film, Buckingham captures the most thought-provoking and heart-felt stories every told by Black males who have experienced the negative and disheartening consequences of growing up in fatherless households. As a Black male who grew up in a fatherless household, Buckingham personally experienced the psychological, social and economic hardships most commonly experienced by Black males who are forced to cope with this harsh phenomenon and has dedicated his life to preventing the vicious fatherless cycle from reoccurring. Buckingham strives to provide Black males with the knowledge and skills essential to establishing and maintaining a positive and productive household.

A Black Man’s Worth! Conqueror and Head of Household premiered at the Tivoli Theater in St. Louis, MO on February 4, 2010, Administration Hall on the campus of University Maryland Baltimore College on March 17, 2010 and the E-Center in Jackson, Mississippi on 31 March 2010. More than 150 people attended all showings and the film received excellent reviews from college students, parents and professionals from various backgrounds. Dr. Leon Chestang, Dean of the School of Social Work at Jackson State University, states, “I have been in the social service field for over 20 years and have reviewed hundreds if not thousands of films about issues that affect Black males and Mr. Buckingham’s documentary *“A Black Man’s Worth”* is one of the best I have ever seen.
